## RECENT ATTACKS ON THE COLONIAL MACHINE IN THE TERRITORY KNOWN AS NORTH AMERICA

**April 29th 2016:** Police vehicles and Donald Trump supporters are attacked outside a Trump rally.

**April 26<sup>th</sup>:** A car dealership is attacked with explosives.

**April 23<sup>rd</sup>:** Hundreds confront police protecting a white power rally, constructing barricades and throwing fireworks and rocks at cops.

April 20th: Anti-gay preachers are attacked outside of a high school.

**April 14<sup>th</sup>:** Police are attacked by molotov cocktails during a spontaneous demo against recent police killings.

**April 12<sup>th</sup>:** A log loader is sabotaged.

**April 11<sup>th</sup>:** Police and government buildings are attacked during a demonstration against an officer killing of a native man.

**April 6<sup>th</sup>:** Police vehicles burned and corporate property attacked during a demonstration against an officer killing of a black man.

**April 1st:** Sacred Rock camp is established, blocking the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline.

March 30<sup>th</sup>: The van of a neo-nazi band is extensively vandalized.

**March 19<sup>th</sup>:** Donald Trump campaign office is vandalized repeatedly.

March 11<sup>th</sup>: Inmates at Holman Prison riot, setting fire to the facility and blockading their dorm.

March 9th: State Penitentiary personnel are assaulted multiple times by inmates.

**February 27<sup>th</sup>:** On the 43rd anniversary of the Wounded Knee takeover, armed demonstrators eject police attempting to stop the march.

**February 26<sup>th</sup>:** Multiple upscale businesses are extensively vandalized in a gentrifying neighborhood.

**February 25<sup>th</sup>:** Police are attacked with molotov cocktails after arresting a volunteer at a squatted social center.

**January 31st:** A TELMEX car is burned in solidarity with prisoners.

**January 30<sup>th</sup>:** Multiple luxury cars are vandalized in an expensive neighborhood.

**January 27<sup>th</sup>:** A police vehicle is damaged during a high school walkout.

**January 25<sup>th</sup>:** Two Enbridge pipelines are sabotaged.

**January 3<sup>rd</sup>:** An Enbridge pipeline is sabotaged.

**December 31st 2015:** A BMW is burned in a gentrified neighborhood.

**December 23<sup>rd</sup>:** An explosive device is placed at a Catholic church.

**December 20<sup>th</sup>:** A cop car is burned.

**December 15th:** Government buildings are burned during a demonstration by indigenous communities.

**December 7th:** A demo against a planned neo-nazi rally attacks corporate property when the fascists fail to show.

**December 2<sup>nd</sup>:** A private security vehicle has its tires slashed.

November 23<sup>rd</sup>: Multiple ATMs are vandalized.

**November 18<sup>th</sup>:** Police are attacked with rocks and molotovs while their station is vandalized after a recent shooting of a black man.

**November 11<sup>th</sup>:** The windows of an expensive condo building are smashed.

**November 2<sup>nd</sup>:** Two banners are dropped and a highway is barricaded against the dumping of sewage in the St. Lawrence river.

October 31<sup>st</sup>: An explosive device is left at a government building.

October 22<sup>nd</sup>: Indigenous militants block Canadian Pacific Railway train lines.

October 19th: The offices of three different politicians are extensively vandalized.

October 12<sup>th</sup>: Christopher Columbus statue painted with graffiti that says "Fuck White Power."

October 5th: An explosive device in left at the Nuclear Sciences Institute.

October 2<sup>nd</sup>: A police station is extensively vandalized during an overnight shift change.

**October:** A campaign of graffiti is carried out expressing solidarity with the Unistot'en camp.

Instructions for poster: 1. Make photocopies of the reverse side of this poster. 2. Cook wheatpaste (three parts water to one part flour, slowly heated on a stove while stirring). 3. Use brush to apply wheatpaste to visible surface. 4. Place poster on surface and apply a second layer of wheatpaste on top. 5. Stay safe.

The list is not even close to complete and the attacks have been chosen for no particular reason. Every attack is based on the complicity and support of broader communities, and building those is no less important of a task.
