E 4 | HAND SIGNALS FOR MEETINGS

'Meeting! Come to the meeting!'	
'I want to say something' or 'I want to ask something'	
'I have a direct answer to the question that you just asked and can answer briefly'	
'I agree with what has just been said. I like this idea/support the proposal'	
'I disagree with what has just been said. I don't like this idea/don't support the proposal'	

'Veto! I am completely against this idea/this suggestion out of principle!'	
'Please, speak louder. It's hard to understood you'	
'Calm down, stay matter-of-fact, take it easy' or 'Please speak more slowly. I can't keep up'	
'I don't understand. I need a translation' or 'I'm still interpreting, please wait a moment'	
'Please be quiet. Quiet!' ('Stop talking!')	
'I have a suggestion about how we can continue the discussion'	

'I need a break' or 'Let's pause for a moment. I have a very important organisational point that can't wait.'	
'I understand what you are saying. Come to the point. You are repeating yourself and going around in circles' or 'I think we are going around in circles'	
'I'm confused. I don't get it. I don't understand what this is about.'
